

Ron Bones Taylor

October 9, 1940 - April 23, 2017

Ronald Lee "Bones" Taylor, longtime Cushing resident, passed away on Sunday, April 23, 2017 at the age of 76 years.

The son of the late Ravle Lee Taylor and Thida Fern Thrasher Taylor, Ron was born on October 9, 1940 in Oxford, Arkansas. He was raised in that area until the age of 11, when he moved to Cushing and had been here since that time, graduating from Cushing High School. Ron was united in marriage to Judy Kremsner on July 31, 1975 in Chicago, Illinois and they started their life together in Cushing.

Ron was a member of the First Assembly of God Church. He was very active in the church; serving as Deacon and teaching Sunday School. Ron was known as an entrepreneur, pipeliner and farmer. He loved music; he was a musician at heart and loved sharing his music with others. He worked for Shell Pipeline for over 26 years, retiring in 2000. He was an active farmer up until his passing. Ron loved traveling and would travel to wherever he could convince Judy to go; he enjoyed collecting anything, tools, junk, whatever he could find; he loved eating and he especially loved spending time with his family. Ron had a great compassion for his community; he loved being with his high school football buddies, being the praise leader at Jubilee and recently had a hand in helping start the Cushing Secure Haven.
