

## Albert Guss "Pete" Krause

Services for Albert Guss "Pete" Krause, 94, of Temple will be 1 p.m. Saturday January 28<sup>th</sup> at First Lutheran Church. Fellowship will begin at noon at the church. Burial will be in Belfalls Cemetery.
